Dear Dr. Ventura:

On behalf of the Inter-American Commission, I have the honor to address the Honorable Court in relation to the above referenced case.

As the Court is already aware, the Commission experiences some difficulties in gathering information with respect to the above referenced case, due to linguistic and logistical limitations. Because of the former, communications with the persons directly affected are pursued through a designated intermediary, a process which can sometimes be complicated.

Pursuant to receipt of the September 10, 1998 communication of the Court, ref. CDH-10.274/400, the Commission contacted the appropriate person twice via e-mail, and an additional time via telephone. Pursuant to those communications, we are able to inform the Court that the compensation ordered in the case has still not been received by the beneficiaries. We have requested that the family of the victim provide us with as much additional information as possible that could aid in the effectuation of the order of the Court. The Commission's contact person has indicated that they will address the family in this regard as soon as possible. Based on the foregoing, we would hope to be able to offer further information within the next one to four weeks. We understand that it would be useful for the Court to receive all the relevant data as soon as possible.
