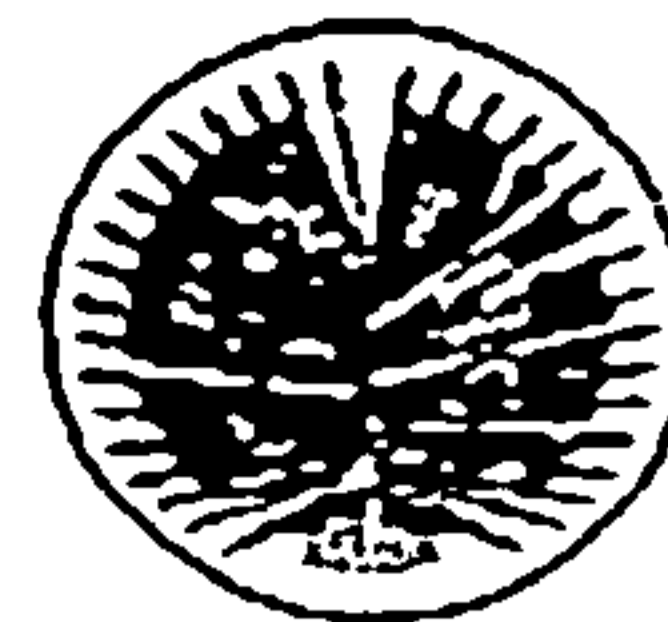

We would note to the Court that Mrs. Panday speaks Dutch, but does not speak English or Spanish.

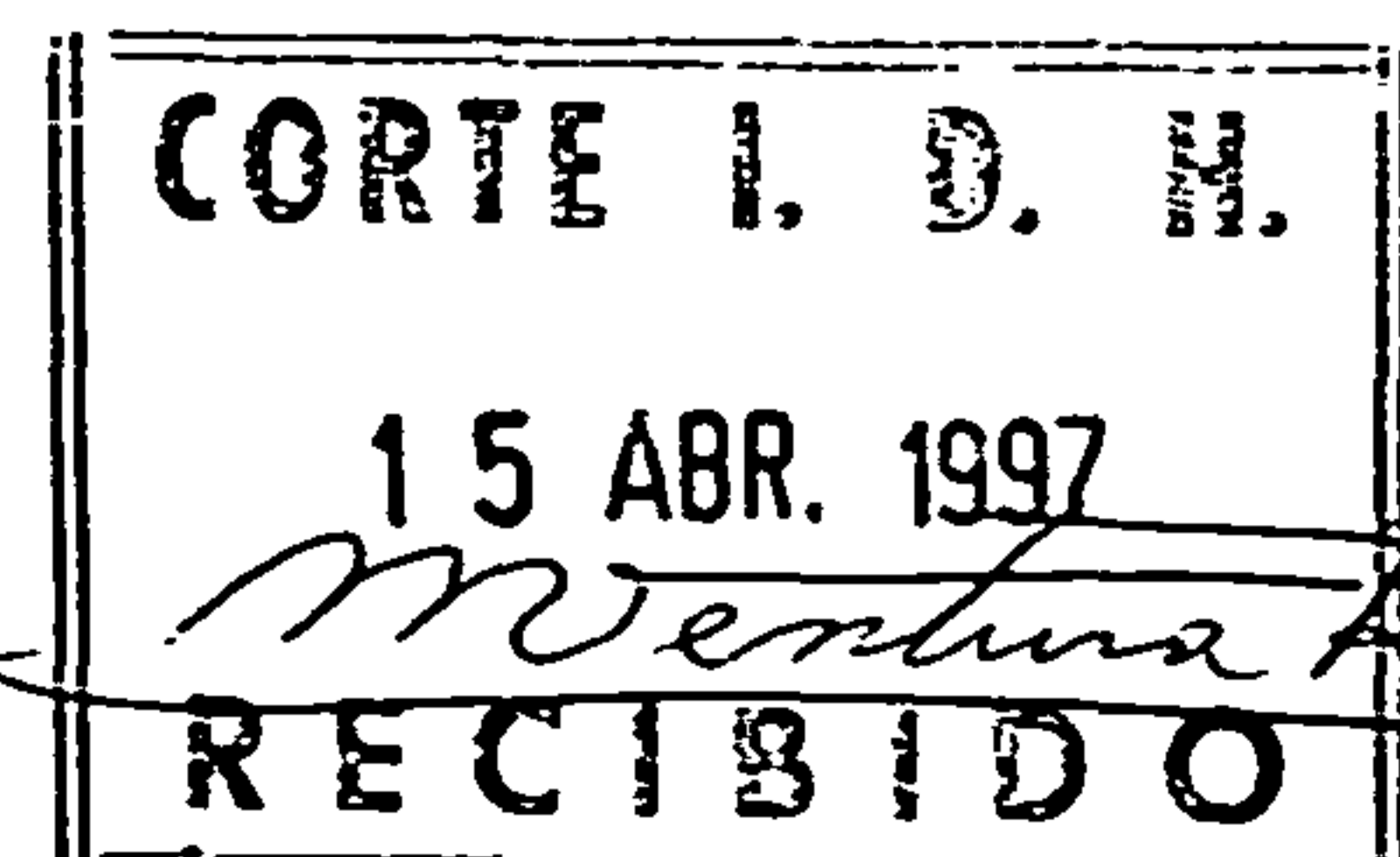


