The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Suriname to the Organization of American States presents its compliments to the President of the Inter-American Court of Human Rights and has the honour to transmit hereby the contents of a letter which was received from the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Suriname.

Quote

Dear Sir,

With reference to the verdict concerning the case of Aloeboetoe et al versus the State of Suriname and the case of Gangaram Panday versus the State of Suriname, I would like to acquaint you with the following.

In compliance with the verdict of the Inter-American Court of Human Rights in the case of Aloeboetoe et al the Government of Suriname has taken measures that resulted in:

- a) the financial compensation of the family of Aloeboetoe et al;
- b) the re-opening of the medical facilities at Gujaba;
- c) the re-opening of the school at Gujaba.

As to the Gangaram Panday case the Ministry of Finance has in accordance with the decision taken by the Government of Suriname judicial deposit a sum of US\$ 10,000,= in a special account in the name of the family of Gangaram Panday.

I am therefore pleased to inform the Court that the Government of Suriname has fully complied with both the verdict on the Aloeboetoe et al case and the verdict on the Gangaram Panday case.

Accept, Sir, the assurances of my highest consideration.

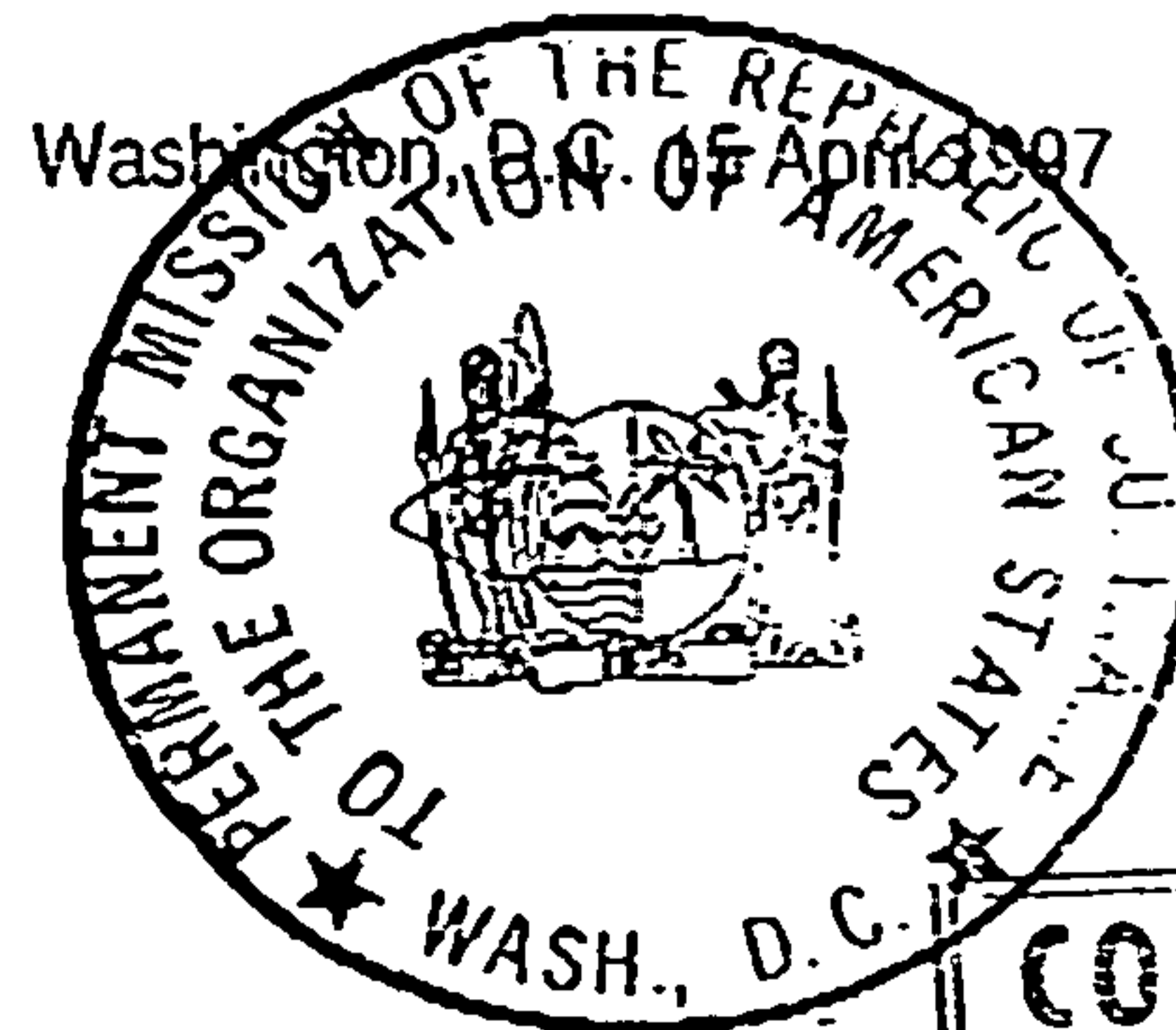
