THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF COSTA RICA AND THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE UN WILL VISIT THE INTER-AMERICAN COURT OF HUMAN RIGHTS FOR THE "40TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE ENTRY INTO FORCE OF THE AMERICAN CONVENTION ON HUMAN RIGHTS AND OF THE CREATION OF THE INTER-AMERICAN COURT OF HUMAN RIGHTS"

San José, Costa Rica, 9 July 2018.- Next Monday, 16 July 2018, his Excellency Mr. Carlos Alvarado Quesada, President of the Republic of Costa Rica and his Excellency Mr. António Guterres, Secretary-General of the United Nations, will visit the headquarters of the Inter-American Court of Human Rights, where there will be a meeting of the Plenary of the Court.

Subsequently, the President of the Court, Judge Eduardo Ferrer Mac-Gregor, together with the President of the Republic of Costa Rica and the Secretary-General of the UN, will unveil the week of events that will be celebrated in commemoration of the "40th Anniversary of the Entry into Force of the American Convention on Human Rights and of the Creation of the Inter-American Court of Human Rights." The inaugural event, which will also include a keynote address by the Secretary-General of the United Nations, will be broadcasted live and will be available from the website of the Court, <http://www.corteidh.or.cr/en>, starting at 18:00 (GMT-6).

As part of these events, the Inter-American Court of Human Rights will hold a private working session on 17 July with the highest representatives of the African Court on Human and People's Rights and the European Court of Human Rights, in which academics of the highest and most renowned professional caliber will also take part, all with the objective to enhance dialogue and cooperation between the three regional human rights tribunals, as well as reflect upon present and future successes and challenges of the regional human rights systems.

In addition, on 18 and 19 July the Court will hold an international seminar that will be based on presentations by representatives of the three regional human rights courts, the Inter-American Commission of Human Rights, various former presidents of the Inter-American Court of Human Rights, as well as representatives of the highest judicial, academic, and civil institutions from different parts of the world. The inauguration of this seminar will take place on 18 July at 9:00 (GMT-6) in the National Theatre of Costa Rica and will be benefited by the participation of the President of the Republic of Costa Rica, his Excellency Mr. Carlos Alvarado Quesada.
