INTER-AMERICAN COURT OF HUMAN RIGHTS RESUMES ACCOUNTING OF ALL DEADLINES

San José, Costa Rica, May 20 2020.- The Inter-American Court of Human Rights resumes the accounting of all deadlines from May 21, 2020, including pending cases, monitoring compliance with judgment, and advisory opinions. The deadlines were suspended in accordance with the Court Agreement 1/2020 and 2/2020 from March 17, 2020, to May 20, 2020.

The deadlines for the presentation of written observations to the request for Advisory Opinion about the "Scope of State obligations, under the Inter-American System with regard to the guarantees of trade union freedom, its relations to other rights and its application from a gender perspective" expires June 15, 2020.

The deadlines for the presentation of written observations to the request for Advisory Opinion about the "Figure of indefinite presidential re-election in the context of the Inter-American System of Human Rights" expires July 24, 2020.
