INTER-AMERICAN COURT HELD A SEMINAR AT THE "JOSÉ SIMEÓN CAÑAS" CENTRAL AMERICAN UNIVERSITY IN SAN SALVADOR, EL SALVADOR

San José, Costa Rica, September 12, 2019.- The Inter-American Court held on August 20 at the "José Simeón Cañas" Central American University (UCA), in the city of San Salvador, El Salvador, an introductory seminar on the Inter-American System for the Protection of Human Rights and the contentious jurisprudence of the Court within the framework of the Project "Training for capacity building on the Inter-American Human Rights System in the university communities of Guatemala, El Salvador and Honduras" signed with the Heinrich Böll Foundation (FHB).



The event took place at the UCA facilities in the city of San Salvador and was supported by the Institute of Human Rights of the Central American University (IDHUCA). It was carried out with the participation of Patricio Pazmiño Freire, Judge of the Inter-American Court; Víctor Rodríguez Rescia, professor, ex-member of the Human Rights Committee and Ex-President of the United Nations Subcommittee on Prevention of Torture and other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment; José María Tojeira, Director of IDHUCA; and Ms. Julieta Di Corleto, Deputy Official Public Defender of the National Ombudsman's Office of Argentina, in charge of

the General Secretariat of Training and Jurisprudence of the Public Ministry of Defense. In addition, participating Court officials gave talks on the Inter-American System for the Protection of Human Rights, the control of conventionality and the contentious jurisprudence of the Court regarding El Salvador. The event was attended by more than 40 people from the university community.




The program was a pioneering initiative of the Inter-American Court aimed at strengthening capacities on the Inter-American Human Rights System in the university communities of Guatemala, El Salvador and Honduras.
