## CYCLE OF HUMAN RIGHTS TRAINING FOR NON-LAWYERS AVAILABLE IN AUDIOVISUAL FORMAT



San José, Costa Rica, January 13, 2021. As part of a permanent communication and training effort being undertaken by the Inter-American Court to ensure that an increasing number of people are aware of how the Inter-American System of Human Rights operates, the Court makes the Initial Virtual Training Cycle in Human Rights available to all those who are interested.

It consists of a collection of eight videos that address basic aspects of human rights in a simple and didactic manner and offer strategies for learning about them and teaching them so as to contribute to the dissemination and protection of human rights in the region.

The initial training material is based on the "Basic Course on Human Rights for non-lawyers," imparted during the second half of 2020 under the project of the Inter-American Court and the Heinrich Böll Foundation: "Training and awareness-raising on human rights in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic."

The material has been prepared so that those interested can obtain direct information on different aspects of the functioning of the Inter-American System of Human Rights; it is also a didactic resource for educators.
