INTER-AMERICAN COURT OF HUMAN RIGHTS HELD ITS 175^{TH} REGULAR SESSION

San José, Costa Rica, May 5, 2025. - The Inter-American Court of Human Rights held its 175th Regular Session from April 22 to May 2, 2025, in virtual format, during which hearings and deliberations were held.

I. Public hearings on contentious cases

The Court held virtual public hearings in the following contentious cases:

a) Guevara Rodríguez et al. v. Venezuela

b) Case of Cuadra Bravo v. Peru¹

c) Case of Rojas Riera v. Venezuela

II. Procedure for taking evidence in the merits stage of a case

A procedure for taking evidence was held privately in the Case of Galdeano Ibáñez v. Nicaragua, in which the alleged victim gave his statement.

III. Monitoring Compliance with Judgment

The Court approved orders on monitoring compliance with judgment in the following cases:

- a) Case of Deras García et al. v. Honduras
- b) Case of Tabares Toro et al. v. Colombia.
- *c*) Case of Members and Militants of the Patriotic Union v. Colombia. The Resolution on this case is available <u>here</u>.

IV. Other resolutions issued by the Court

Two resolutions were issued in the following contentious cases:

- a) In the *Case of Ramos Durand et al. Peru* a resolution was issued regarding Article 53 of the Rules of Procedure of the I/A Court HR.
- b) In the *Case of Moliné O'Connor v. Argentina* a resolution on a request for provisional measures will be notified soon.

V. Monitoring Compliance with decisions and administrative matters

The Court also monitored compliance with various judgments and the implementation of provisional measures that it has ordered, as well as procedural issues in various contentious cases. It also addressed several administrative matters.

1 Judge Alberto Borea Odría, of Peruvian nationality, did not participate in the public hearing in this case, in conformity with Article 19 of the Rules of Procedure of the Court.

The Court's composition for this Regular Session will be as follows: Judge Nancy Hernández López, President (Costa Rica); Judge Rodrigo Mudrovitsch, Vice-President (Brazil); Judge Ricardo C. Pérez Manrique (Uruguay), Judge Verónica Gómez (Argentina), Judge Patricia Pérez Goldberg (Chile), Judge Alberto Borea Odría (Peru) and Judge Diego Moreno Rodríguez (Paraguay).

Some of the matters in this session were heard by the prior composition of the Court, in conformity with Article 5(3) of the Statute of the Court and Article 17 of the Rules of Procedure.
