LAUNCH OF THREE NEW SELF-LEARNING COURSES IN ENGLISH OF THE COURT'S TRAINING CENTER

San José, Costa Rica, September 25, 2025. The Inter-American Court of Human Rights is pleased to announce the launch of three self-learning courses in English by its Training Center.

With these three courses in English, the content and scope of the Court's education process are expanded to reach the specialized public and the general public. The courses are free of cost and universally accessible through a computer or mobile phone with internet. The goal of these courses is to disseminate the work of the I/A Court HR and its jurisprudence. Therefore, there is no evaluation and there is no participation or other type of certificate, with no exceptions.

We would like to thank the cooperation of the Kingdom of the Netherlands which enabled the translation, dubbing and editing of these courses.
