INTER-AMERICAN COURT OF HUMAN RIGHTS HELD AN EXTRAORDINARY SESSION



San José, Costa Rica, December 15, 2023. - On December 12, 2023, the Inter-American Court held an Extraordinary Session.

During this Session it worked on several matters regarding interpretation of Judgment, Provisional Measures and Monitoring Compliance with Judgment that are currently being heard, as well as procedural matters in various Contentious Cases.

I. Interpretation of Judgment

The Court began deliberating the Judgment in the following Contentious Case:

a. Interpretation of Judgment in the Case of Members and Militants of the Patriotic Union v. Colombia¹

II. Orders on Provisional Measures

The Court adopted the following orders on Provisional Measures:

- a. Matter of Members of the Yanomami, Ye'Kwana and Munduruku Indigenous Peoples regarding Brazil²
- b. Matter of Members Choréachi Indigenous Community regarding Mexico³

III. Next Extraordinary Session

The Court agreed to hold an Extraordinary Session on Tuesday, December 19, in order to continue with pending items.
