Response to request from CORTEIDH for a written opinion concerning request for an advisory opinion by the Republic of Colombia

I am writing in response to your letter dated 18 May 2016 inviting the International Maritime Organization (IMO) to present its written opinion on the issues covered by the request for an advisory opinion that was submitted by the Republic of Colombia on 14 March 2016 concerning the interpretation of various articles of the American Convention on Human Rights within the context of the possible impact of grand scale projects on marine environment, particularly in the Greater Caribbean Region.

IMO, a specialized agency of the United Nations, is the global standard-setting authority for the safety, security and environmental performance of international shipping. Its main role is to create a regulatory framework for the shipping industry that is fair and effective, universally adopted and uniformly implemented.

While certain IMO instruments adopted by IMO Member States do require environmental impact assessments to be completed, there is no specific detailed information that would be responsive to your request.
